### **Garage Sales Tips:**

<u>Safety</u> – Keep money and a cell phone in a fanny pack or carpenter's apron. Lock all doors to your house. Work with a partner; one person takes the money while the other watches over the sale.

<u>Preparation</u> – Collect and organize items at least 4 weeks prior to the sale. Categorize items by type. \$60 in change should be on hand, but more than that should go into your house for safekeeping. Price stickers should be placed on the front of items, not bottoms.

**CLOTHING** – Children's clothing sells well but not adults'.

**SIGNS** – Put signs in your yard to attract customers.
