Garage Sales Tips:

- **Safety:** Keep money and a cell phone in a fanny pack or carpenter's apron. Lock all doors to your house. Work with a partner; one person takes the money while the other watches over the sale
- **Preparation:** Collect and organize items at least 4 weeks prior to the sale. Categorize items by type. \$60 in change should be on hand, but more than that should go into your house for safekeeping. Price stickers should be placed on the front of items, not bottoms.
- CLOTHING: Children's clothing sells well but not adults'.
- **SIGNS:** Put signs in your yard to attract customers.

348 Trees Cut Down on Knollwood Golf Course



As reported in the <u>South Bend Tribune</u>, Knollwood Golf Course lost 348 trees to an herbicide intended to help grass grow.

"Knollwood Country Club's golf course in Granger lost 250 trees to Imprelis last year and another 98 this January and February, said General Manager Brian Ihnat. That sounds like a lot, but many of them are scattered throughout a course with thousands of trees, he said. The most visible

losses this year are near the first hole south of Adams Road and west of Gumwood Road."

The golf course is working with the herbicide's manufacturer to replant the affected trees as part of a class action lawsuit.

Do I really need to pump my septic tank, if so how often?

The following quote is taken from the Indiana Onsite Wastewater Professionals Association.

"YES, PUMP YOUR TANK: Tanks need to be pumped every two to five years, depending on use. If the tank gets too full, particles of scum or sludge will flush out of the tank. This material will clog the drain tiles and cause the septic system to fail."
